## Recital 2026!

Dance Central holds a recital every year. This year our recital is scheduled for June 5 & June 6 at the beautiful, new CFISD Visual and Performing Arts Center! Each student is invited to participate. Most classes will only participate in one show. Select classes will perform in more than 1 show.

Teachers begin working on recital dances after the Christmas break. Music and costume selection happens in the fall and a parent is required to attend a fitting, dress rehearsal and purchase the recital costume. At this time, the color and type of shoes required for the recital dance will be finalized.

Participation in the recital is not mandatory. The recital is a wonderful opportunity for students to showcase what they have learned during the year, and provides a fun, non-threatening performance opportunity.

Regular attendance to weekly classes is crucial to a good recital performance. Dance Central takes great pride in putting on an amazing show each year. We want each dancer to feel confident and proud of his/her individual performance within the group. However, to make a finished dance, all team members must have mastered the dance well and must have been in regular attendance throughout the year. If too many classes are missed by a particular dancer, the director may need to speak with the student's parent about eligibility for participation in the recital.

**Recital Fees Due:** To offset the cost of theater rental and theater staff, a recital fee is due per student participating in the show. The budget for the show is based on total number of students participating; therefore, recital fees are not refundable. Recital fees are due in November. The recital fee is \$105 on or before November 1<sup>st</sup> and \$120 after this date. All recital fees are due by November 21. Each dancer will receive 4 complimentary tickets and a recital T-shirt. Additional tickets will be available for purchase.

## Monthly Statements/Credit Card Payment

Statements are emailed to the account on file a few days before the first of every month, giving you time to review your account balance. If you are enrolled in automatic payments, the full balance will be charged to your card on the first of the month. If the first falls on a Sunday or a holiday your credit card will be charged on the next business day. **October tuition will be charged on Wednesday, October 1.**
