News to Know!

Class Schedules / Placements – We are evaluating class placements. If we see that your child needs to be placed in a different class we will notify you.

We are closed Labor Day weekend! The studio will be closed from Saturday, Sept. 1 – Monday, Sept. 3.

Credit Card Payment NOTE: We are able to accept credit card payments for tuition, company fees, costumes and Dance Central merchandise. You must come in to the studio and fill out a NEW form at the beginning of each school year.

Arriving/Departing:

Students must wear street shoes to and from the studio. Please plan on dropping off students 5 to 10 minutes before their class starts. Dancers need time to put their dance shoes on and get mentally and physically ready for class. Parents should pick up students 5 to 10 minutes after their class time is finished. Dancers will need to get their dance bag, put their shoes away, and say bye to their friends and teachers. If everyone adheres to pick up and drop off times, the process will go more smoothly and it will help alleviate traffic concerns. Please also be mindful of the speed limit on Jarvis (30 mph). When dropping off/picking up, please pull your car up all the way forward to the end of the sidewalk (still allowing a space for cars to come out of the side lot). Do not stop at the double doors.
